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Activities	0 points No activities for student to perform or participate in.	2 points Simple activities such as clicking on links.	4 points Complex activities such as needing to complete a task before continuing tutorial.	
Answers a question	0 points Does not answer a typical reference question.	2 points Adequately answers a common reference question from students.	4 points Answers a common reference question and encourages the student to further explore their interest.	
Location meets requirements				
Logical main location	0 points Location difficult to find unless one is shown it because very little thought when into its placement.	2 points Location seems logical but it is hard to know for certain because very little testing or discussion takes place among Library staff regarding its placement.	4 points Location is selected by Library staff that regularly answers reference questions and intuitively knows the best place to make the tutorial available to students.	
Multiple access points	1 points Only one access point.	2 points At least two access points but cannot be included in a course website or Learning Management System (e.g. Moodle).	4 points Multiple access points and can be easily included in a course website or Learning Management System (e.g. Moodle)
