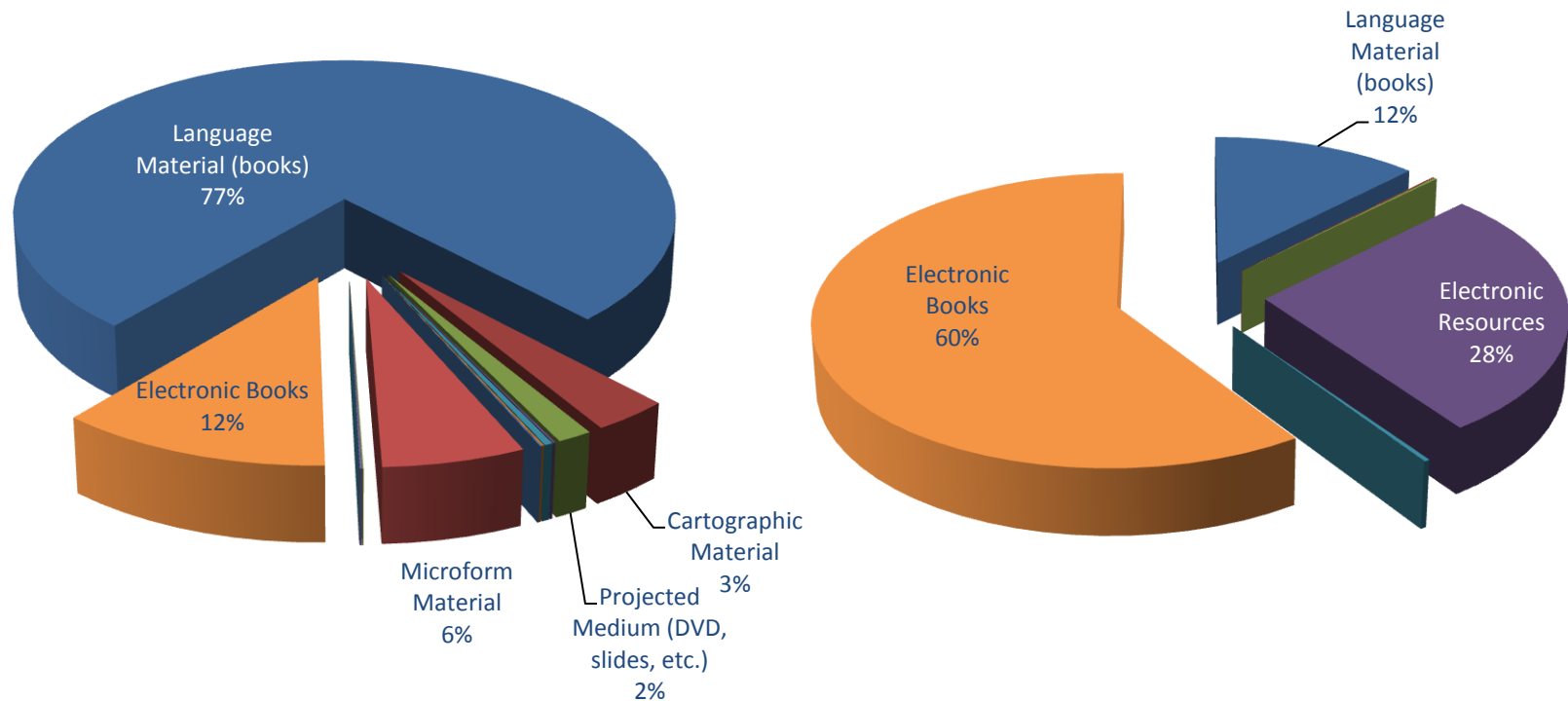

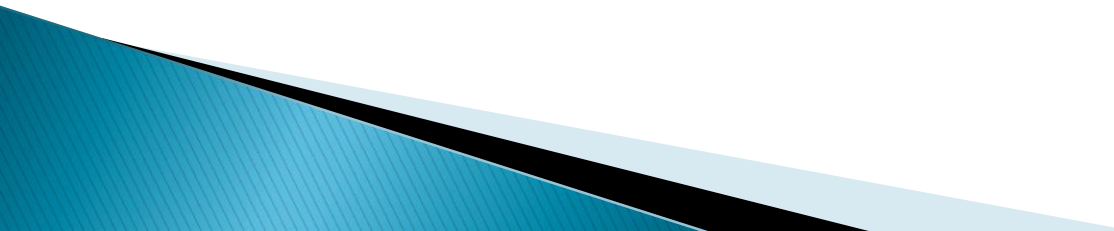
UNBC: percentage of bibliographic records loaded by material type

Modifying records

Please begin by reviewing the field count, there should be an equal number of LDR fields, 050, 245, 260, 300 and 856. The field count is useful for noticing any oddities, such as not enough 050 fields. Then have a look at a couple of the existing records in the catalogue to see what notes, added entries, series, etc. are in those records and aim for consistency, to see what notes, added entries, series, etc. are in those records and aim for consistency with past practice for that vendor.

Evaluating records

- ▶ Quality issues: accuracy, completeness
 - ▶ Compatibility issues: display of diacritics
 - ▶ Access issues: Do the records add access value to the resources described?
 - ▶ Workload issues: how much editing/updating will be required? How will it be accomplished and who will do it?



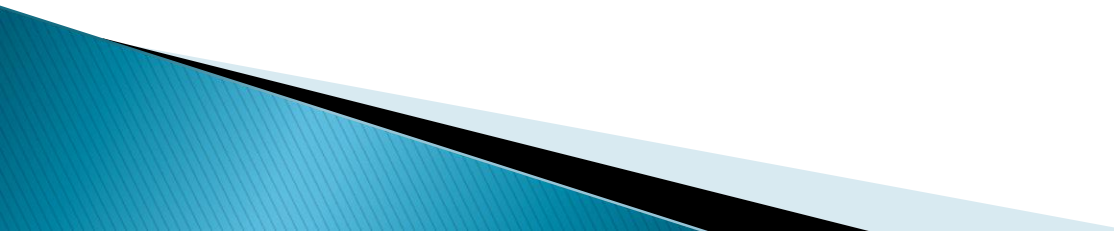



“...It was agreed that a reconstituted task group could undertake the first four recommendations in the report, provided the focus is on e-books and the group can provide timelines. M. Swanson volunteered a representative from UVic to serve on the task group.

The recommendations are:

- ▶ Formalize a licensing model for e-books that can be negotiated with vendors based on the criteria disclosed above and other relevant models (e.g. OCUL);
 - ▶ Co-ordinate a regional collections policy that might address issues such as ILL lending and perpetual access;

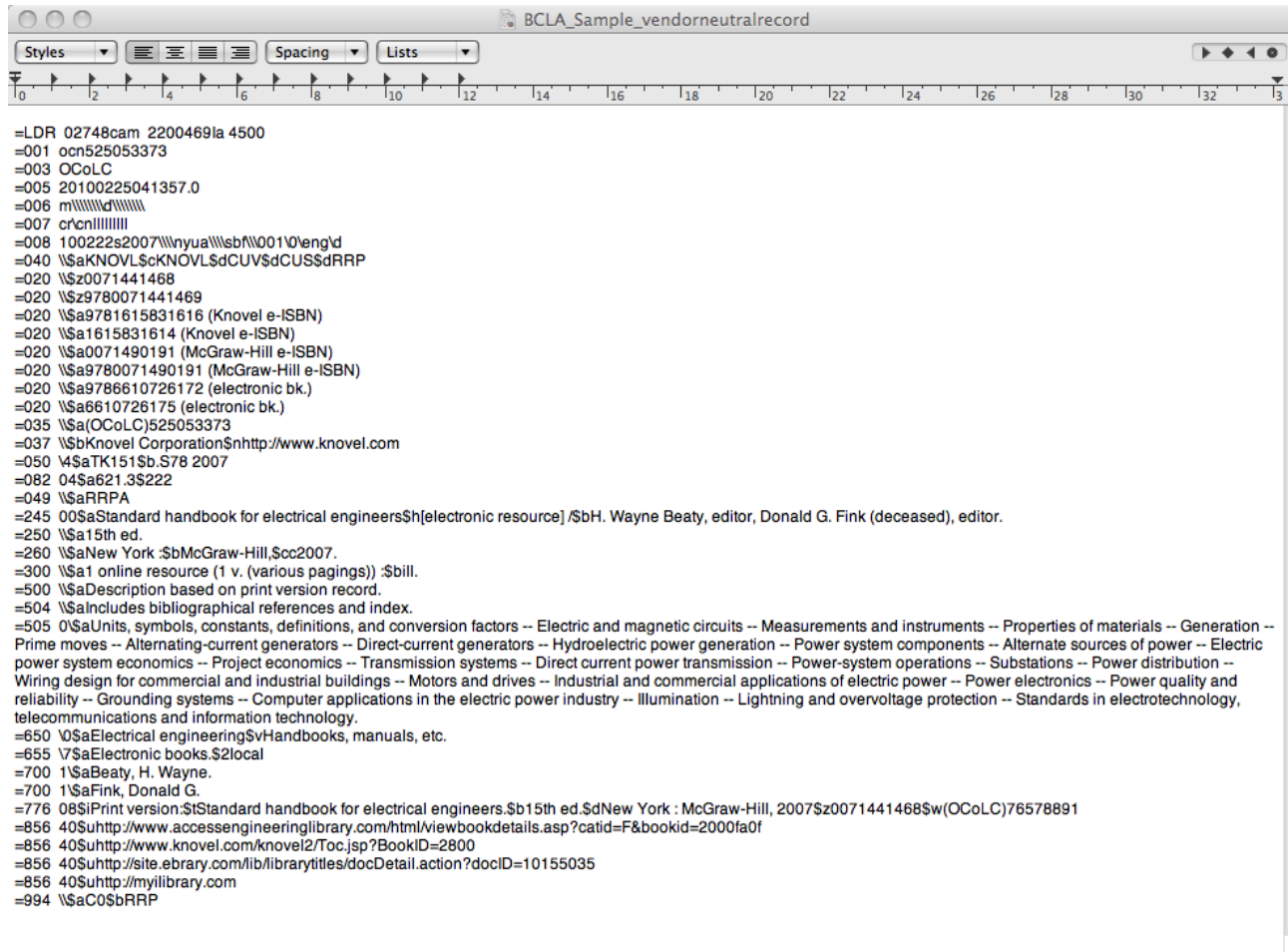
