

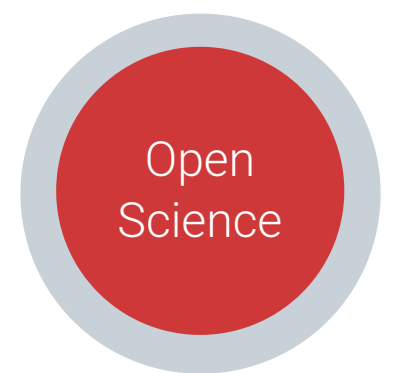

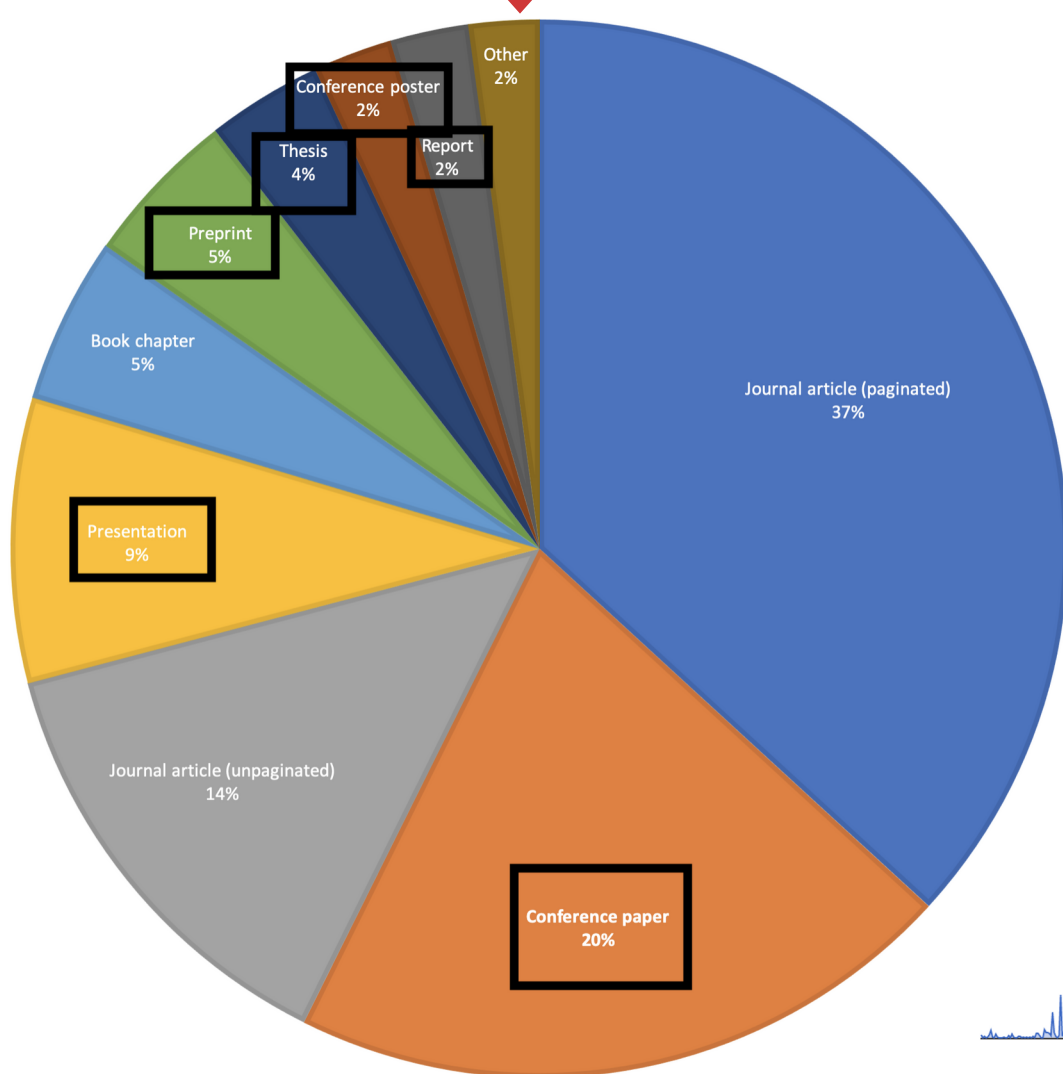


Are materials and research produced by organizations outside of the traditional commercial or academic publishing and distribution channels.

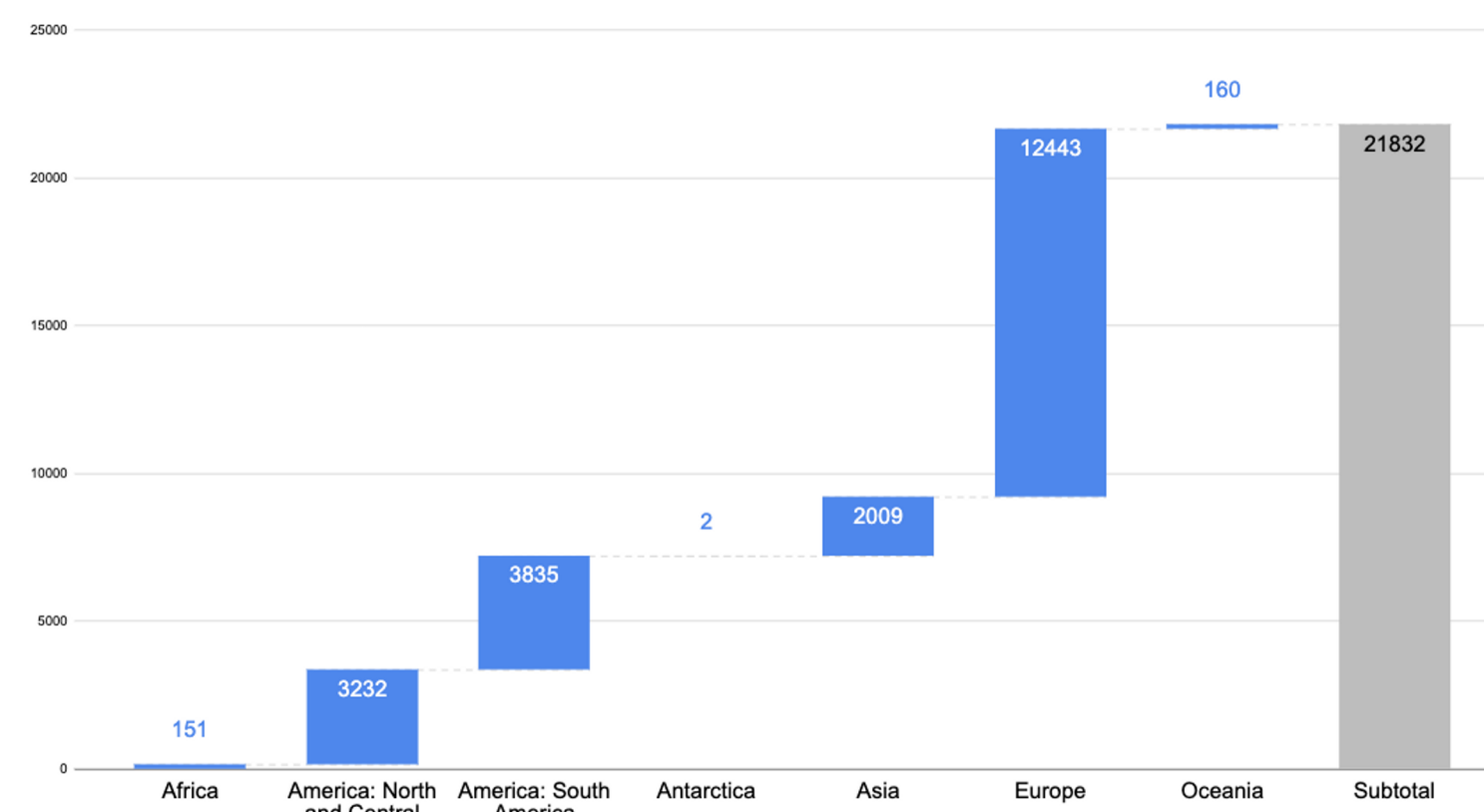

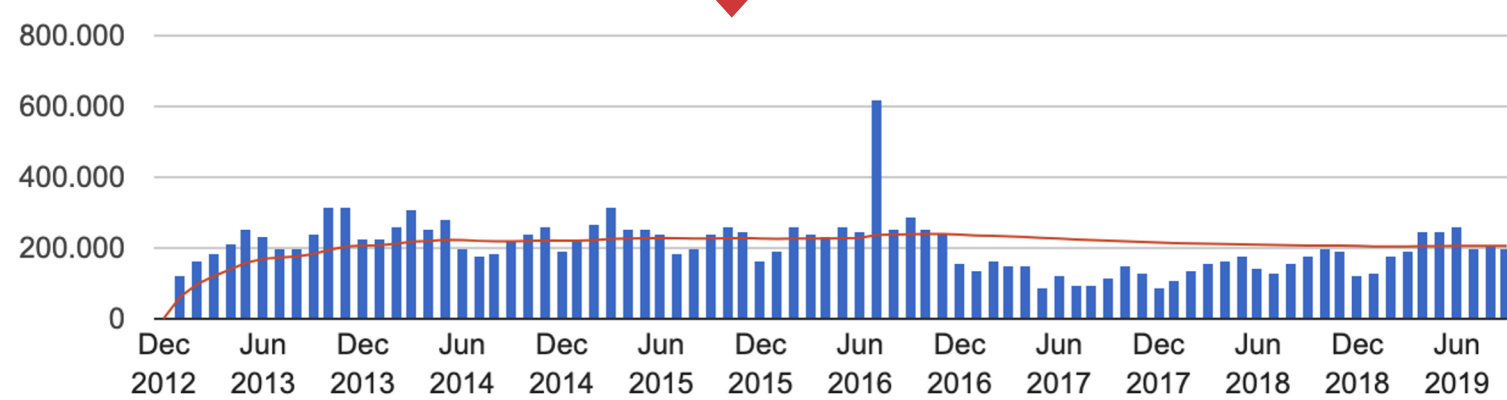

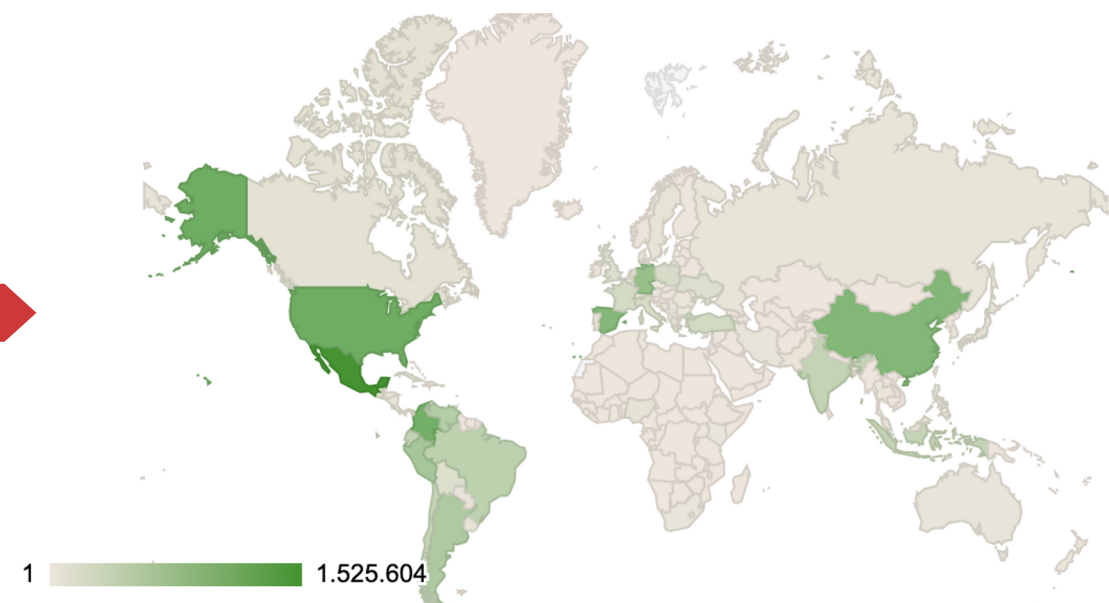
