History





- The University of A Coruña (UDC) was created in 1989
- Previously, it was part of The University of Santiago de Compostela
- Part of the library structure derives from those times, with libraries in each faculty or school
- The University Library was previously installed in the Rectorate building. Then it was transferred to the present building in 2006

- The UDC Library network comprises the University Library and 16 service points, that give day to day service to students and researchers within their subject area

 - Ferrol

2018



- **The Library gives service to:**
 - 17,032 students, both degree and postgraduate
 - 1,423 teachers and researchers
 - 2,690 users from outside the university
 - 791 university staff
- **Library staff:**
 - 53 librarians
 - 32 library assistants
 - 1 administrative assistant
- **Holdings:**
 - Print: titles
 - Books: 487,692
 - Journals: 1,329
 - Non-book materials: 32,880
 - Electronic: titles
 - Books: 114,776
 - Journals: 30,411
 - Databases: 41
 - Items in repository: 17,716

- Located at the Xoana Capdevielle building, in Elviña, A Coruña

- Organisation:

- Library director
 - Departments:

- *Information and Reference:* library web, social media, learning support, library's information desk
 - *Collection management:* selection and management of electronic collections
 - *Internal support and infrastructure:* library management system, OPAC, repository, research support
 - *Document supply:* interlibrary loan, external users



Learning Support



- **Basic information search skills:**
 - Place: each faculty or school library
 - Scope: basic information retrieval (OPAC) and library services
 - Recipient: mainly freshers
- **Advanced information search skills:**
 - Place: each faculty or school library
 - Scope: advanced information retrieval (e-journals, databases), searching strategies, using referencing styles, plagiarism, reference managers...
 - Recipient: students preparing the final degree/master project, postgraduate students

Learning Support



- **Research support:** in collaboration with CUFIE - University Centre for Training and Educational Innovation (<https://www.udc.es/en/cufie/>)
 - Place: Moodle and faculty/school libraries
 - Scope: researcher identifiers, publishing support, bibliometrics, information searches....
 - Recipient: teachers and researchers, postgraduate students
- **Other courses:**
 - Place: University Library
 - Scope: Specific courses on certain aspects of interest for both students and researchers
 - **2019/2020 call:**
 - Documentary resources for theses and other academic works
 - Scientific networks
 - ISI vs Scopus: metrics of information
