



Development of LIS research in India and data was collected from "University New" Theses of the Month from 2005 to 2010. Key Word -Trend, Doctoral Dissertation in LIS.

Introduction: During the recent past quite a number of research activities have been carried out in the universities and research institutions in various part of the India. The Role of libraries in research, teaching and learning process in the institution of learning cannot be overemphasized consequently the library provide an alternative that can make available the information source & resources for the intellectual growth of both the students and professors. Research is the most important intellectual activities in the higher education system which provides dependable solutions to the problems being manifested in various fields of knowledge. Objectives:


To examine the recent trends & growth of LIS research in India.




year wise analysis of Ph.D. awarded: It is show on table No.1 that early year of this study ph.D. award below the 10% and in next two years it increases 2 to 3 percent but in 2007 it ph.D. at increases twice rate than 2005. 20.73% in 2008, 22.50% in 2009 and 23.78% in 2010. University wise Ph.D. awarded: During the total period of 6 years (2005 to 2010) of Library and Information Science research covered under this study, 164 Ph.D. have been awarded by 55 universities. It shows that out of 55 universities 21 universities awarded only 01 Ph.D. theses it means they cannot get attention toward the research in LIS. Among that 55 universities only 11 universities awarded 5 or more than 5 Ph.D. theses. In that only 2 universities achieve the double figure. It shows that most of LIS department not get more attention toward the research in LIS and also the submission of thesis data in Association of Indian Universities (AIU). Delhi.






States wise university Contribution: There are 55 universities in 20 states of India which are offering Ph.D. programme and awarded 1 to 35 Ph.D. Table No 3 show the providing data of only 05 high performing states which are awarded 105 Ph.D. These 5 states have 64.02% (105/164Ph.D.) of total research output. In that Madhya Pradesh is on top contributing 21.34% Ph.D. follows that Andhra Pradesh 15.85%, Karnataka 10.36%, Maharashtra 9.14% and Uttar Pradesh 7.31%. Other than that 05, 03 and 01 Ph.D. from other states.



Madhya Pradesh, Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka and Maharashtra are most awarded Ph.D. States in these study. Newly introduced themes are mostly use for the Ph.D. titles.In this IT era that is Library services in IT Environment, web & ICT Sources, Bibliographic and Scientometric Study etc. We surprise that 9 theses do not have details of research guide 11 Ph.D. are in three different languages and 2 Ph.D. awarded by Other than LIS department also.

Conclusions: The present study shows that the research in LIS was at low & increased slowly and continuously present study has observed last three year crossed the record of first three years. LIS department getting the attention toward the research.
